Privacy Policy

Zero Inbox Technologies Ltd. understands that Your privacy is important to You and that You care about how Your information is used and shared online. We respect and value the privacy of everyone who visits Our sites or uses Our application (our “Services”) and will only collect and use information in ways that are useful to You and in a manner consistent with Your rights and Our obligations under the law.

This Privacy Policy describes Our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of Your information when You use our Services and tells You about Your privacy rights and how the law protects You.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully and ensure that You understand it. Your acceptance of Our Privacy Policy is deemed to occur upon Your first use of our Services or You will be required to read and accept this Privacy Policy when signing up for an Account. If You do not accept and agree with this Privacy Policy, You must stop using our Services immediately.

We use Your Personal data to provide and improve the Service. By using our Services, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy is incorporated into and forms part of our Terms of Service.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- **Account** means a unique account created for You to access our Service or parts of our Service.
- **Affiliate** means an entity that controls, is controlled by or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.
- **Application** means the software program provided by the Company downloaded by You on any electronic device, named Zero Inbox ● **Company** (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Zero Inbox Technologies Ltd., 903-1618 West 6th Avenue, Vancouver, BC.
- **Country** refers to: British Columbia, Canada
- **Device** means any device that can access the Service such as a computer, a cellphone or a digital tablet.
- **Personal Data** is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.
- **Service** refers to the Application.
- **Service Provider** means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of the Company, to perform services related to the Service or to assist the Company in analyzing how the Service is used.
- **Usage Data** refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).
- **You** means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data You Provide

We may collect Your name, email address, and payment information when You register for our Service, sign up for our mailing list, or otherwise communicate with us. We may also collect any communications between You and Zero Inbox and any other information you provide to Zero Inbox. We may use this Personal Data to contact or identify You.

The amount and type of information that Zero Inbox gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. Zero Inbox collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of Your interaction with Zero Inbox. Zero Inbox does not disclose personal data other than as described below. And visitors can always refuse to supply personal data, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain activities.

Personal Data We Collect Automatically

The personal data we collect automatically when using the Service is referred to as Usage Data.

Usage Data may include information such as Your Device's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that You visit, the time and date of Your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When You access the Service by or through a mobile device, We may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device You use, the IP address of Your mobile device, Your mobile operating system, and the type of mobile Internet browser You use.

We may also collect information that Your browser sends whenever You visit our

Service or when You access the Service by or through a mobile device.

In order to make the most accurate suggestions on organizing Your Inbox, our algorithms momentarily analyze your Emails such as Sender Name, Sender Email Address, and Email Contents. This information is only stored for the purposes of showing you Emails we found with Suggestions on which Labels to move them to. These Emails with the Suggestions are stored for the duration of your Logged In Session. Once you click Sign Out, all Email data is deleted. This means the next time you come back to Zero Inbox, we start fresh, with no history of your prior use other than whether you paid or not.

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- **To provide and maintain our Service**, including to monitor the usage of our Service.
- **To manage Your Account:** to manage Your registration as a user of the Service. The Personal Data You provide can give You access to different functionalities of the Service that are available to You as a registered user.
- **For the performance of a contract:** the development, compliance and undertaking of the purchase contract for the products, items or services You have purchased or of any other contract with Us through the Service.
- **To contact You:** To contact You by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as a mobile application's push notifications regarding updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products or contracted services, including the security updates, when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.
- **To provide You** with news, special offers and general information about other goods, services and events which we offer that are similar to those that you have already purchased or enquired about unless You have opted not to receive such information.
- **To manage Your requests:** To attend and manage Your requests to Us. ● **For business transfers:** We may use metadata about our users such as user count, and purchase history (not associated to You) to conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding. However, Personal Data will never be shared to any entity by

Us.

- **For other purposes:** We may use Your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and to evaluate and improve our Service, products, services, marketing and your experience.

We never share Your personal information in any scenario.

Retention of Your Personal Data

We only keep Your usage data for the duration of the logged in Session. We delete all of your Usage data described in the Usage section after you log out of your Session. The only Data that is kept by Zero Inbox is your Login data, in order for you to seamlessly log in to our Service again. Also, we keep a payment record history, in order for your Payment to last between sessions. This ensures that you can log in again, without disruption of service.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of Your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from Your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by Your submission of such information represents Your agreement to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that Your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of Your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of Your data and other personal information.

Delete Your Personal Data

You have the right to delete or request that We assist in deleting the Personal Data that We have collected about You.

Our Service may give You the ability to delete certain information about You from within the Service.

You may update, amend, or delete Your information at any time by signing in to Your Account, if you have one, and visiting the account settings section that allows you to manage Your personal information. You may also contact Us to request access to, correct, or delete any personal information that You have provided to Us.

Please note, however, that We may need to retain certain information when we have a legal obligation or lawful basis to do so.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Transactions

If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, Your Personal Data will not be transferred. Any data used in a merger or asset sale will be strictly Metadata. Metadata involves usage numbers such as logins, and total emails cleaned. Payment metadata involves the total revenue that Zero Inbox generates. However, none of this metadata involves any personal information such as name, or email.

Law enforcement

Under certain circumstances, the Company may be required to disclose Your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g. a court or a government agency).

Other legal requirements

The Company may disclose Your Personal Data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:

- Comply with a legal obligation
- Prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the Service
- Protect the personal safety of Users of the Service or the public
- Protect against legal liability

Security of Your Personal Data

The security of Your Personal Data is important to Us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While We strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect Your Personal Data, We cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Children's Privacy

Our Service does not address anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13. If You are a parent or guardian and You are aware that Your child has provided Us with Personal Data, please contact Us. If We become aware that We have collected Personal Data from anyone under the age of 13 without verification of parental consent, We take steps to remove that information from Our servers.

If We need to rely on consent as a legal basis for processing Your information and Your country requires consent from a parent, We may require Your parent's consent before We collect and use that information.

Google User Data Policy

Zero Inbox connects to your Gmail account via Google APIs. Zero Inbox Technologies' use and transfer to any other app of information received from Google APIs adheres to the [Google API Services User Data Policy](#), including the Limited Use requirements.

1. We **never** transfer your data, other than to comply with applicable laws.
2. A human never reads the data, unless to comply with applicable laws and security purposes.
3. We do not transfer or sell your data for any reason, including ads.
